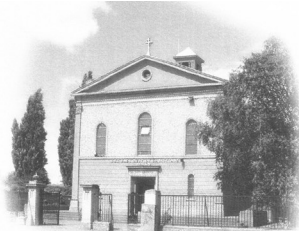

TEXT ALERT: We are inviting residents to renew their subscription to the Navan Road Text Alert Scheme. We will be collecting renewals in the Parish Centre before the next NRCC meeting at 7.30p.m. on Wednesday 5th February 2020. Renewal applies to anyone who joined the scheme prior to January 2019. DOG FOULING: We are again appealing to dog owners to pick up after their pets. It has been estimated that a single gram of dog waste can contain 23 million faecal coliform bacteria, which are known to cause cramps, diarrhoea, intestinal illness and serious kidney disorders in humans. Dog waste can also cause Toxocariasis, a potentially lethal disease which can result in blindness. So please be a good neighbour and pick -up after your dog.
