"If you don't find a priest to go to for confession, speak to God. He's your father. Tell him the truth. 'Lord. I did this & this & this. Pardon me.' Ask his forgiveness with all your heart, with an act of contrition, and promise Him, 'Afterward I will go to confession. You will return to God's grace immediately.'"

John 11: 1-45 -Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead.

Our faith invites us to turn to God for help with life's challenges. Martha makes a wonderful expression of faith to Jesus, 'I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who has come into the world.' We need to turn to God, to keep on praying. When we suffer it seems as though God is absent. But when we pray we come to realise that God is not absent, he is present in our suffering. God is with us as our HOPE in adversity, and our strength in weakness. We are not alone!
