ONGOING CORONAVIRUS MEASURES

As you are aware the Government has announced that the whole country is to move to level five restrictions. All places of worship can remain open for private prayer only. Therefore all public Masses in our church are suspended for at least five more weeks. Mass will be celebrated daily in the parish church as per the following schedule:

Monday to Saturday 9am and 10am. 9am Mass will be offered for all on the Altar Lists of the Dead for the month of November.

Sunday: Vigil mass at 6:30pm Saturday and 9am and 10:30am Sunday morning. No congregation can be present. These Masses will be streamed on the parish webcam and the parish radio.

If you wish to receive confession, please approach any of the Priests when you meet them, they will be happy to accommodate you.

Funeral Masses will take place at **10am** with limited numbers of **25**.

THE CHURCH WILL BE OPEN FOR PRIVATE PRAYER AS PER THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

Monday to Friday after the 10am morning Mass until 4pm

Saturday after the 10am morning Mass until 6pm

Sunday after the 10:30am morning Mass until 4pm.

When you are visiting the church for private prayer we ask that you **FOLLOW HSE GUIDELINES WITH REGARD TO SOCIAL DISTANCING, SANITISING YOUR HANDS AND FACE COVERINGS MUST BE WORN.** **In the interest of hygiene and the safety of all our parishioners may we ask that you do not touch or kiss the many statues, the altar or other items in the Church.**
