Excerpt from a reflection on The Holy Trinity by Br. Silvester O' Flynn OFM Cap

“Our God is not an abstract philosophical concept, nor a mysterious remote control, but a community of intimate relationships in giving, receiving and returning. What is given is life and love.....Pay attention to the great prayers of the Church’s liturgy and it will deepen your understanding of the Blessed Trinity. The Eucharist Prayer, at the centre of Mass, ends with this beautiful prayer.

“Through him (Jesus), and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all glory and honour is yours, for ever and ever.”

The direction of worship is to the Father. The way is **through** Jesus as our mediator, **with** him as our brother in human nature, and **in** him as members of his body. By the Holy Spirit expresses the power of divine love dwelling in us.

We are made in the image and likeness of God. We are Trinitarian, people who are not isolated individuals but deeply inter-related in life and love.

NAVAN ROAD COMMUNITY COUNCIL

BUS CONNECTS planning procedures; We received following information from a local public rep, following queries to NTA the unelected body deciding all plans for Bus Connects;

NTA has begun a pre-application consultation process with An Bord Pleanála (ABP), working on the basis that all CBC applications to ABP would be made simultaneously - not decided yet and may change, subject to the pre-application consultation process and other logistical factors. Once the statutory planning applications are formally made to ABP the process of engagement transfers to ABP - this means that the public can then make observations directly to ABP during a formal period, after it is submitted.

On making the applications, NTA will publish the application documentation so that the public can access the information to consider it, and decide then if they wish to submit observations to ABP. Following that statutory consultation period, ABP will determine if an oral hearing is appropriate to facilitate consideration of the application, and the observations, prior to determining consent, or not, or if an oral hearing is deemed unnecessary, then ABP will proceed directly to determining consent, or not. We indicated previously the necessity for an oral hearing & a proper 'public consultation'. We will be requesting that all future 'consultations' are indeed 'public', not only online/depriving all those people not on line of all information - disenfranchising them. We hope to set out next week, a list of trees along Navan Road threatened with removal - almost all we fear. See our webpage: www.navanroadcc.com
