**Announcement of a concert in Phoenix Park** on Saturday 26th June, for 3,500 seated, was made at very short notice, giving no time or invitation to the public to submit on the matter. NRCC are not objecting, but are lodging concerns, to both Ministers, making such announcements - Minister for Culture Catherine Martin, and Minister O'Donovan from Limerick, with responsibility for OPW, as well as to our 3 T.D.s Leo Varadkar; Jack Chambers; Roderic O'Gorman; all our local Councillors; Garda Commissioner; and OPW.

Among Major Concerns: **Sufficient Gardaí** must be on duty throughout all residential areas surrounding the Park, to ensure families are not locked into their homes by traffic to event, this must include local Gardaí familiar with areas; **Gardaí on all gates** of Park to prevent drink being taken in to the Park; **How to deal** with hundreds expected to arrive in the Park to listen to event outside the concert location; **Clear directions** to prevent concert goers getting lost within the Park after event; **A direct bus route** TO the Park, preferably free, or low priced, which could include small pocket maps, with directions within the Park; **Our suggestion** to have a bus set down/pick up at Parkgate St., or along Constitution Hill, or within St. Bricin's grounds; **Portaloos** adjacent to the event site (unknown to date) to protect the Park, as well as local gardens from misuse; **Sufficient litter bins**, with company employed to clear away immediately after event, and to visit the Phoenix Park on morning after event to remove all litter left behind; contact with local hospitals to arrange one ambulance route in/ out of Park, if required.

We are suggesting ideal site for music events is the Bandstand at The Hollow, close to bus routes along N.C.R. and Parkgate St. Garda Band traditionally played small concerts there.
