Feast of The Nativity of John the Baptist Thursday 24th June

Jesus said: "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John" (Lk 7:28). Jesus honoured John above all other men and so it is fitting that we honour him too.

John was probably born at Ain-Karim, which is southwest of Jerusalem. As a young adult, he lived as a hermit in the desert of Judea until about A.D. 27. When he was 30, he began to preach on the banks of the Jordan, calling for repentance and baptising people in the river waters. When Jesus came to John to be baptised, John recognised Jesus as the Messiah and baptised Him, saying: "It is I who need baptism from you."

John continued to preach after Jesus was baptised, but was imprisoned not long after by Herod Antipas, after he denounced the king's adulterous marriage with Herodias, wife of his half-brother Philip.

John was beheaded at the request of Salome, daughter of Herodias. Many came to know Jesus through John, namely the Apostles Andrew and John.

AMORIS LAETITIA- A FATHER'S PRESENCE—POPE FRANCIS

God sets the father in the family so that by the gifts of his masculinity he can be "close to his wife and share everything, joy and sorrow, hope and hardship.

And to be close to his children as they grow – when they play and when they work, when they are carefree and when they are distressed, when they are talkative and when they are silent, when they are daring and when they are afraid, when they stray and when they get back on the right path.

To be a father who is always present.

When I say 'present', I do not mean 'controlling'. Fathers who are too controlling overshadow their children, they don't let them develop". Some fathers feel they are useless or unnecessary, but the fact is that "children need to find a father waiting for them when they return home with their problems. They may try hard not to admit it, not to show it, but they need it". It is not good for children to lack a father and to grow up before they are ready.

Dear God, Thank you for all the fathers and father-figures in this world and for the many ways you use them to lovingly guide others to Your heart. I ask that you would bless them and give them great joy and peace. May they see You and know You in new ways. Show them how much you love them and care about them. Guide their steps, use their hands, and make them a blessing to others as you continue to fulfil your special purpose for their lives. Amen.
