**SACRAMENTS OF FIRST PENANCE AND
FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2022**

Dear Parents/ Guardians & Girls.

I hope you and your families are well at this challenging time. We are now making preparations for registering for the Sacraments which will take place in our Parish of Our Lady Help Of Christians in 2022.

I wish to invite you to REGISTER for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Holy Communion. Please find a registration form attached. Please complete the form fully and return it with a copy of your daughter's **baptismal certificate** and **€10** towards sacramental expenses, **on the evening of registration.**

If you do not have a baptismal certificate, one can be requested from the parish office of the parish where your child was baptised. In compliance with data protection regulations, certificates can only be collected by a parent or a person with a letter of consent from the parent. Any person, including the parent of the child, collecting a baptismal certificate must produce photo ID (e.g. Passport, Driving license, Social service card).

In the event that your child is not baptised, and you are Catholic and wish your child to be baptised and receive the sacraments of First Penance and First Holy Communion you must contact me (Fr. O'Brien) urgently at 018681436. If your child was baptised in another Christian Denomination and wishes to receive the above sacraments, then he/she must, with preparation, be received into the Catholic Church, again you need to make urgent contact with me (Fr. O'Brien).

Registration will take place on Monday 6th December in the Parish Centre (behind the Church) from 6.00p.m to 8.00pm. Please call in at any stage during these hours to register your daughter for the Sacraments.

There will be a one- way system entering and exiting the Centre. Please wear a face mask at all times and please stay socially distanced from other families.

We look forward to meeting you on Monday 6th December.
