PHOENIX PARK: Remembrance Day 5k Run Sunday 13th November - some road closures 8.30 - 12.00 and Chesterfield Ave., overnight - 10.00pm Sat to 2.00 p.m. Sunday. On Sunday, Castleknock Gate closed 9.45-10.30. and no right turn inside Ashtown Gate from 9.00 - 12.00 .

Parking in the Park; re-opened area inside Ashtown Gate needs re-seeding, we just learned it is closed over winter.

Remember, left turn inside Cabra Gate has a line of spaces. More parking both sides of Park : Cricket Grounds -61; Camogie Grounds-97; Soccer Pavilions-102; Gaelic Pitches, Military Road -44; Upper Glen -39; Bottom Kyber area-16; Knockmaroon Gate-24; Knockmaroon layby -7. With the newly added 220 along North Road (inside Cabra Gate) - there are approximately 2,200 car parking spaces within our Phoenix Park. We continue to oppose plans which could turn it into the largest free car park in Dublin, and to ask for return of the single-decker Shuttle Bus WITHIN the Park, a 'Hail & Ride' option, with no ugly bus stops/bins/commercial advertising to bring people from to/from favourite spots.
