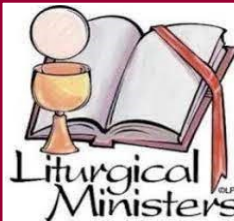

COUNCIL****Phoenix Park Parking Strategy- Survey-**The second stage public consultation was
launched 18th April, with a closing date for pub-
lic to submit on **22nd May**. We are writing to
our public reps requesting this be extended, out
of respect for our National Historic Park, which
is subject to the protection of several EU
Charters and Conventions.The Draft Parking Strategy can be found online
at [https://www.phoenixpark.ie/draft-parking-
strategy/](https://www.phoenixpark.ie/draft-parking-strategy/) You are invited to review the Draft
Parking Strategy that provides a comprehensive
vision for parking management in the Phoenix
Park. A survey is in the same link above and
takes less than 5 minutes to complete. A small
hard copy version of all proposals can be seen at
Visitor Centre, Phoenix Park but there are no
enlarged drawings/pictures to view.A suggested submission is printed, with instruc-
tions to 'hand in to reception' - we respectfully
suggest you might write your own letter and

Street, Trim, Co. Meath C15 NX36.We are glad to see that the OPW have taken our
suggestion made many years back, that the
former shuttle bus, from Heuston area along
Chesterfield Avenue to Visitor Centre, and
possibly along other side roads, be reintroduced
to bring people in and around the Park,
