We attended Navan Road/ Pelletstown Police Forum on 8th June. Extra Gardai have been appointed to Cabra Station. The new Community Sgt. was welcomed, as was the news that Cabra Station now has a dedicated squad car, which it is hoped will ensure faster response to reported incidents.

BUS CONNECTS have written to people who submitted on our Blanchardstown to City route, who requested an Oral Hearing. The Oral Hearing has been refused to both our and others' great disappointment, but Bord Pleanála have suggested to those who requested an Oral hearing, to submit again on the original application as per Section 217B of the Planning & Development Act, 2000, by 12th July. Ref No, ABP 313892-22. We can only suggest people doing so, no longer refer to the Oral Hearing, but state that they wish to add..... as they feel appropriate.
