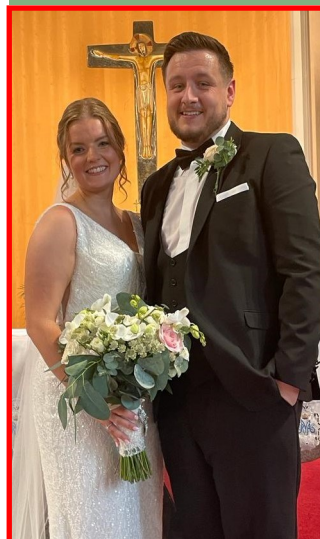


CROSSCARE ANNUAL APPEAL 2023

ELECTORAL BOUNDARY CHANGES - recent

whatsoever were granted to our area - we are still in DUBLIN WEST which will now have 5 T.D.'s, and our

Councillors are still left in Dublin Central, as before. We are being disenfranchised by the bizarre division of

Dublin Central. We had requested a full return of our area into Dubin Central, with 5 T.D. seats, and with our

Councillors in the same area. Consideration of the expanding population due to development within the

greater area does not appear to have taken place.

PLEASE-we appeal to people not to dump clothes/ bottles etc. beside the re-cycle bins at Ashtown Grove.

Apart from attracting rodents to smells of empty bottles, and birds to pick the bags open, it is very disrespectful to
