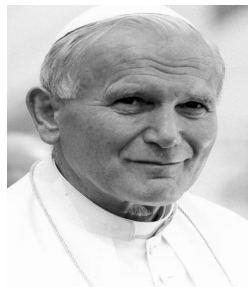

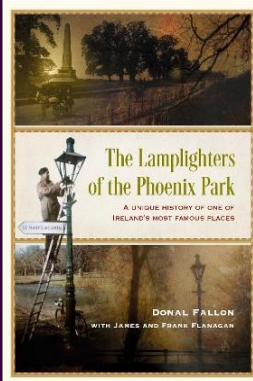

of every month.**FROM: NAVAN ROAD COMMUNITY COUNCIL**We attended the Oral Hearing in An Bord Pleanála  
offices over past 2 weeks, Tuesdays to Fridays. We  
emphasised the importance of NOT closing off  
Ashtown Road to both sides of our communi-  
ties, throughout Ashtown to Skreen Road We hand-  
ed in a professional drawing, to show the Railway  
Engineers how to lower the rail line between  
Pelletstown and Navan Road stations, going under  
Ashtown Road, leaving it open to all; The same  
professional confirmed the former railway-cottage,  
beside Ashtown level crossing, would not be  
damaged by such works, as it was "deliberately  
engineered to remain stable from train vibrations, is  
extremely robust, and was designed to be a structur-  
al buttress to the wall of the Lock..." We informed  
the Bord Inspector of the Post Office's new location -  
**ON THE FAR SIDE FROM OUR NAVAN ROAD  
COMMUNITY**, which, if the level crossing &  
Ashtown Road were closed off, would necessitate  
all pedestrians walking over & back on an even  
larger footbridge than the one now there (current  
bridge 28 steps each side - proposed bridge approx.  
48 steps each side) with a deep traffic tunnel under  
the Canal. Lowering the line would reduce the  
enormous costs of both a tunnel and a major foot-  
bridge. The Hearing ended on Friday 13th. The  
Railway Order under which I. Rail made application  
gives them great powers over community areas on  
either side of the tracks, BUT, the Inspector can  
override much of this, if he recognises the disrup-  
tions to communities, from Ashtown to Maynooth -  
with proposed closures of 5 level crossings.
