The Parish 'Travelling Crib' will begin its journey around the parish on **Sunday 3rd Dec. , the**

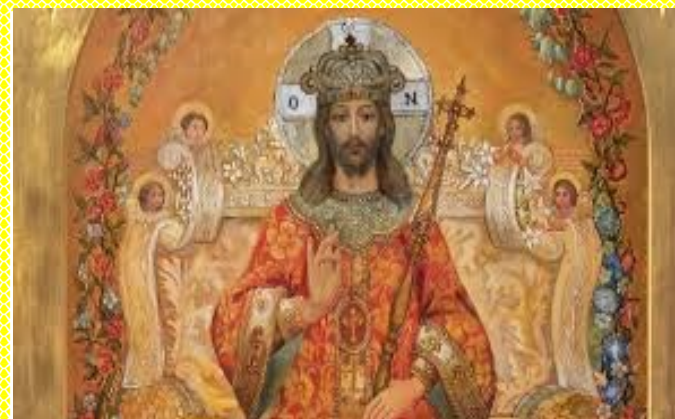
First Sunday of Advent, at 12 Noon
