

BLACKHORSE AVENUE:- We have, this week, sent a Letter of Support to Blackhorse Avenue residents, to add to their very detailed request, with drawings/pictures, to Dublin City Council, (DCC), to have the long delayed Blackhorse Avenue roadworks completed, from Baggot Road to St. Vincent's Cottages, first raised with DCC in June, 2001. The residents have forwarded all to our local Councillors and T.D.'s. We have written to DCC. about this issue over several years, and will be forwarding our support letter to our local DCC Councillors. We have sent fresh pictures to DCC, Cabra Office, and to our Councillors, of leaf -fall all over footpaths, now extra slippy with frost, (TAKE GREAT CARE) - as well as a third picture, showing a very dangerous hole on the road at the top of Blackhorse Avenue, where many people cross over to enter the Phoenix Park, at the Ashtown Gate entrance, DCC Cabra Office have confirmed - 'repairs to the hole in road at top of Bl. Ave. will be carried out in the New Year, an inspector is to call out to see it'. This was first reported by us earlier this year - no date in 'New Year' given.
