POPE FRANCIS’ FEBRUARY PRAYER INTENTION- FOR THE TERMINALLY ILL

Pope Francis releases his prayer intention for the month of February 2024, and invites everyone to pray for the terminally ill and their families. “When some people talk about terminal illnesses, there are two words they often confuse: incurable and un-‘curable.’ But they are not the same. Every sick person has the right to medical, psychological, spiritual and human assistance . Healing is not always possible, but we can

always care for the sick person, caress them. Such care guarantees the patient not only medical attention, but also human assistance and closeness. Those suffering should not be left alone in these difficult moments. The role of the family is decisive and relatives need access to adequate means so as to provide appropriate physical, spiritual and social support.”

Pope Francis concludes by asking for prayers and a commitment from everyone so that “the terminally ill and their families always receive the necessary medical and human care and assistance.”

Thursday 8th February– Day of Prayer & Awareness against Human Trafficking

Feast Day of St. Josephine Bakhita. In 1877, when Josephine was 7–8 years old, she was seized by Arab slave traders, who had abducted her elder sister two years earlier.

She was forced to walk barefoot about 960 km. to El-Obeid and was sold and bought twice before she arrived there. Over the course of twelve years (1877–1889) she was sold three more times and then she was finally given her freedom. Eventually she was left in the care of the Canossian Sisters in Venice. There, cared for and instructed by the Sisters, Bakhita encountered Christianity for the first time.

Grateful to her teachers, she recalled, *"Those holy mothers instructed me with heroic patience and introduced me to that God who from childhood I had felt in my heart without knowing who He was."*

Each Year approx. 2.5 million people are still victims of trafficking & slavery.
