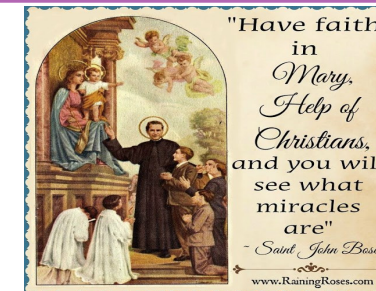

contact DCC to get the bin companies to remove ugly piles of rubbish left beside the recycle area. Anything with food particles will attract RATS, especially during this cold weather. **A recent Radio Ad** for -mywaste.ie - stated that you can bring all electric goods, such as Fridges, Washing Machines, Hair Dryers. even 'Lawnmowers' and more, i.e, 'anything with an electric plug, battery or cable. Mywaste.ie do not have a phone number or contact address to facilitate many people not on the internet. The site contains maps of the various bring centres, and a long alphabetical list of electrical items.

This may be a good time to clear out old electrical items. Remember also when purchasing new electrical items the shops will recycle your old one.
