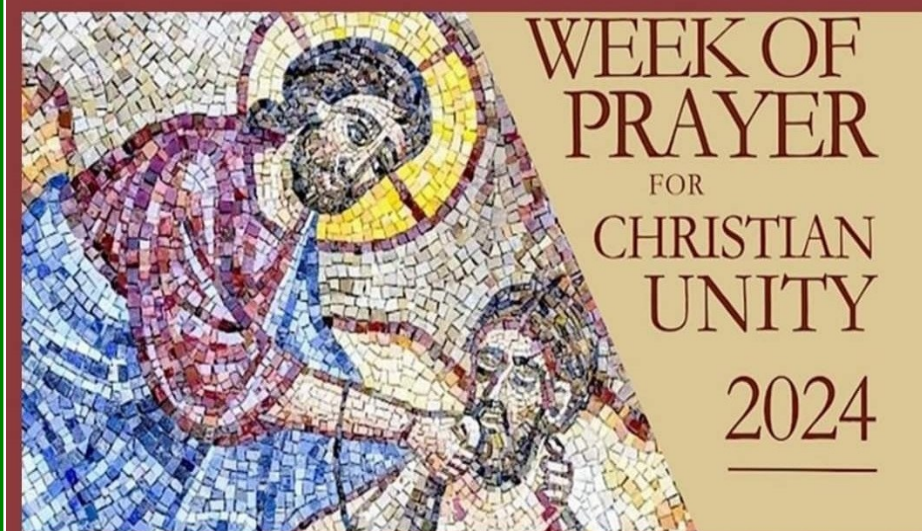

We only noted over New Year's National papers, an invite from "Dublin City Council (DCC) for the public to participate in a proposed amendment to the Planning & Development Act, as amended", i.e., "proposed variation No. 5 to the Dublin City Development Plan 2022-28 - to make a technical update to the DCC Dev. Plan, in relation to 'Build-To-Rent (BTR) accommodation on foot of the publication of Sustainable Urban Housing: Design standards for new apartments - Guidelines for Planning Authorities DHLGH, 2023" This is described fully in 'two amendments, A and B'. "Reason - 'the purpose of the proposed variation is to make a technical update in relation to 'Build to Rent' BTR accommodation' ".
