IMPORTANT local issue - **PLANNING SITE NOTICES** at entrances to Martin Savage Park playing fields; re; No. 5032/23, as submitted to Dublin City Council (DCC) by Dublin City Council itself, on 21/12/23 as follows; "under Planning & Development Act 2000, as amended Planning & Development Regulations 2001, as amended; Applicant; DCC Culture, Recreation & Economic Services Dept." (this is submitted under Section 8 Planning) - "for the development of all weather" **SYNTHETIC** "astro pitches with fencing around, and floodlighting, playground & garden planting area," (among several items). Site notices state "DCC have decided there is no likelihood of the proposed development having significant effects on the environment, therefore an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is not required.

NOTE; There is no fee to submit Section 8 applications, but there is also no Appeal stage after any decision. The plans can be seen between 9.00 a.m. - 4.30 p.m. at Planning Counter, DCC offices, Wood Quay, or, at Cabra area offices, 97 New Cabra Road - (122 & 38 bus stop beside it) . Submission can be posted to Executive Manager, Planning & Property Development Dept., DCC, Wood Quay, Dublin 8. by **4.30p.m. on 12th February** or online to the new Citizen Portal at
