Inaugurated in 2010, (first meeting 14/10/10), the original plan was to hold 4 meetings per year in alternate locations (Navan Rd Parish Centre & Pelletstown Community Centre). In the past couple of years, the meetings, organised by DCC, with Agenda by DCC, have dwindled to only one meeting being held in 2023, in Pelletstown Educate Together School Hall, with limited parking.
