



Following our reminder last week of the 9 excellent exercise machines in Martin Savage Park, along the footpath - some people have asked for more information, especially the 4 which can be used from a wheelchair, as indicated on them - these are the four: 1 - "medium intensity aerobic workout, tones & exercises all upper body muscles, builds muscles in arms & shoulders". 2 - "enhances & strengthens upper arms, provides workout for back muscles, develops physical co-ordination". 3 - "Increases hand & wrist flexibility, exercises arms & shoulders, provides good upper body toning". 4 - "Strengthens upper arm muscles, enhances shoulder flexibility, stretches arms & waist and provides good all-over body toning". There are access points from Ashtown and Glendhu ends, and even easier via normal gateway through Plunketts Club area, with pathway leading down to the machines.
