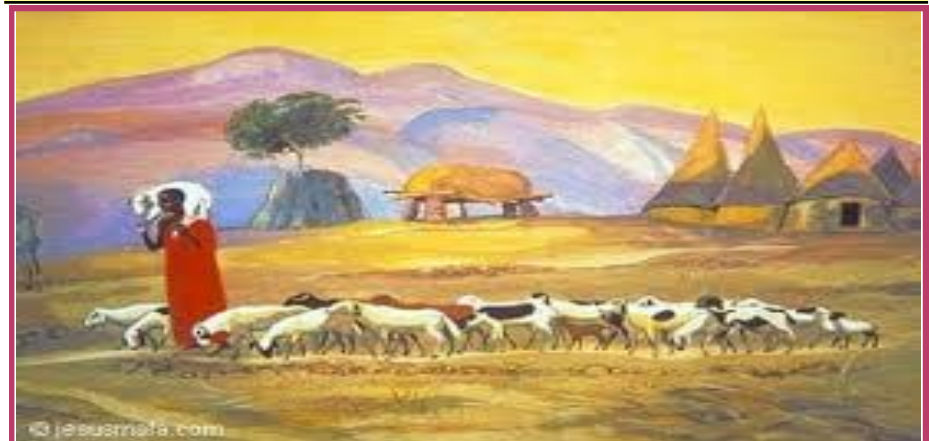

"I AM A MISSION ON THIS EARTH" Pope Francis

God's call, includes a "sending". There is no vocation without mission. There is no happiness and full self-realisation unless we offer others the new life that we have found. God's call to love is an experience that does not allow us to remain silent. Saint Paul says, "Woe to me if I do not proclaim the gospel!" (1 Cor 9:16). And the First Letter of John begins with the words, "What we have heard and seen, looked at and touched - the Word made flesh - we declare also to you, so that our joy may be complete" (cf. 1:1-4). Our shared mission as Christians is to bear joyful witness wherever we find ourselves, through our actions and words, to the experience of being with Jesus and members of his community, which is the Church. That mission finds expression in works of material and spiritual mercy, in a welcoming and gentle way of life that reflects closeness, compassion and tenderness, in contrast to the culture of waste and indifference. By being a neighbour, like the Good Samaritan (cf. Lk 10:25-37), we come to understand the heart of our Christian vocation: to imitate Jesus Christ, who came to serve, not to be served (cf. Mk 10:45).

operating, organised by our CommunityGardai. In case it may be of help to people, here
are some points of information, if you are in debt,
or in danger of becoming so, MABS try to help by
way of advices - it is a FREE, INDEPENDENT,**NON-JUDGEMENTAL** service. They

operate a 5 step programme, if possible, such as -

*research the problem; *assess/help develop a

budget; *decide/suggest a plan; *review

it; *monitor it; *implement the plan - including

on mortgage arrears, managing money/forming a

regular budget plan. They can also contact a

Community Welfare Officer, if required. MABS

also endeavour to help with issues such as Social

Welfare appeals, NOTE; Citizen Advice also help

with such appeals. They informed us that Credit

Unions can operate a low cost microloan
