

God's call, includes a "sending". There is no vocation without mission. There is no happiness and full self-realisation unless we offer others the new life that we have found. We recently attended a talk by MABS (Money Advice & Budgetary Service), over 30 years operating, organised by our Community Gardai. In case it may be of help to people, here are some points of information, if you are in debt, or in danger of becoming so, MABS try to help by way of advices - it is a FREE, INDEPENDENT,

NON-JUDGEMENTAL service. They operate a 5 step programme, if possible, such as *research the problem; *assess/help develop a
budget; *decide/suggest a plan; *review
it; *monitor it; *implement the plan - including
on mortgage arrears, managing money/forming a
regular budget plan. They can also contact a
Community Welfare Officer, if required. MABS
also endeavour to help with issues such as Social
Welfare appeals, NOTE; Citizen Advice also help
with such appeals. They informed us that Credit
Unions can operate a low cost microloan
