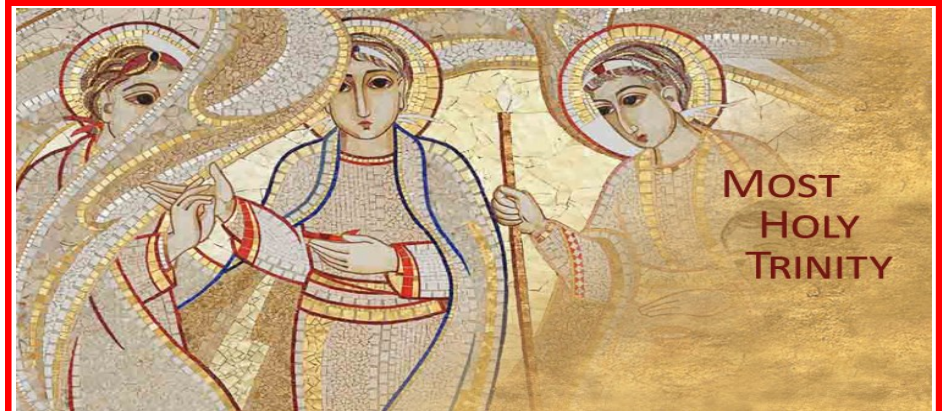

### REFLECTION
