Dog Owners code of conduct in the Park and THEY MUST BE ON A LEAD if close to Deer areas/Peoples Gardens/Visitor Centre/close to horse trekking/bicycle lanes. Ground nesting birds and Deer Herd are sensitive to disturbance by both dogs and people - Deer can be very intolerant during rutting and fawning (giving birth), usually June/July. DO NOT FEED THE DEER. Peoples food is not good for deer, and may cause illness. If you see a fawn hiding in long grass, PLEASE DO NOT DISTURB, its mother, the Doe is close by minding it. Under Control of Dogs Act, 1986 owners of restricted breeds must have their dog on a lead and muzzled, being led by a sufficiently strong chain or lead. GUIDE DOGS ARE EXEMPT. If you see restricted dogs without muzzle or leash, contact Park Rangers at 087 2289698 or 087 2289688.
