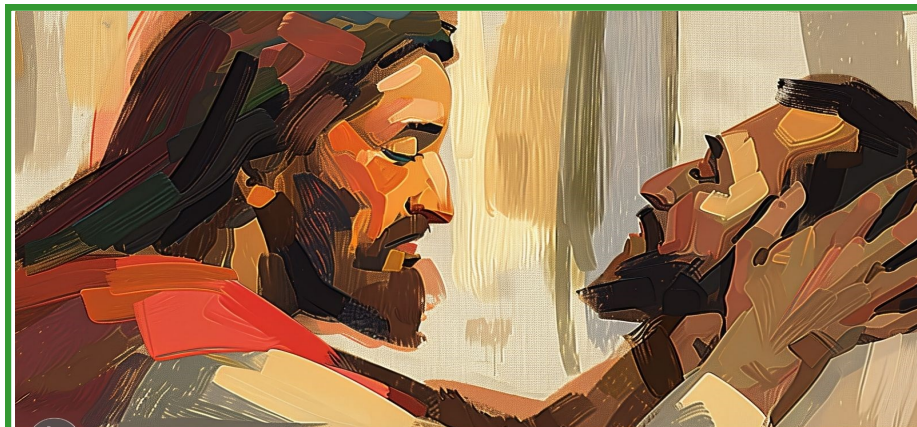

**RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION IN CHURCH**

We are aware that some people attending  
Mass in our church have restricted mobili-  
ty and may find it difficult to leave their  
seats to receive the Blessed Sacrament.

To assist people the Blessed Sacrament is  
distributed to people in the front seats of  
the church, without them having to leave  
their seats.

As the aisles in the church are narrow one  
of the priests, the deacon or a Minister of  
the Eucharist will go down to people in  
the wheelchair area in the centre of the  
church and/or to anyone who may find it  
difficult to leave their seat, once they are  
made aware of the need.

Coeliac hosts are available at all Masses.  
After the "Sign of Peace" anyone who is  
able can come up beside the Baptismal  
Font to receive the Blessed Sacrament. If a  
person is unable to do so, please let one of  
the priests, the deacon or a Minister of the  
Eucharist know and one of us will go  
down to the person in their seat.
