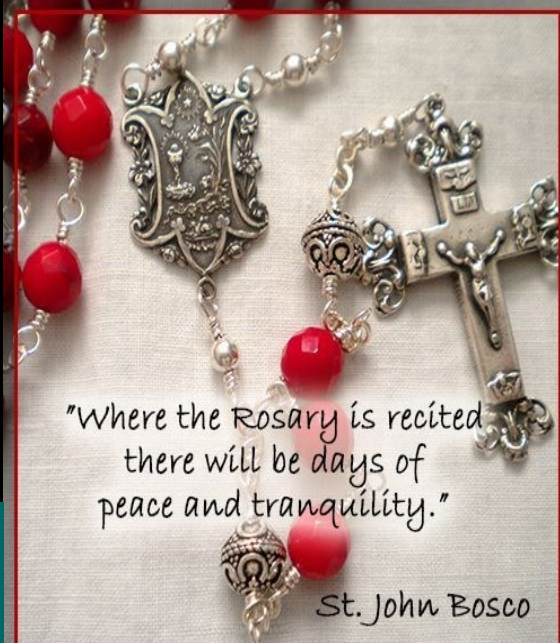

NEW BUS SERVICE: N2 runs from
Heuston Station to Clontarf Road. This
is the bus route planned previously
which would not fit through the Phoenix
Park, Cabra Gate. Bus Route: Heuston to
Stoneybatter, Manor St., left to NCR, like
No 37, and right to Blackhorse Ave-
nue, Nephin Road across Navan Road
to remainder of Nephin Road, on to
Broombridge Station(main reason for
this route is to connect to Broombridge,
and main line trains) along Ballybogan
Road, left to Glasnevin Road, then right
to Glasnevin Downs, left to Ballygall
Road on to Griffith Avenue passing the
Mater Hospital Clinic and Marino
Institute, Marino Church - St Vincent's
GAA Club - also crossing Drumcondra
Road Upper & St Mobhi Rd /a left to
Ballymun Ave. brings walking distance
to DCU - right to The Rise / back to
Griffith Ave. End Griffith Ave. right to
Brian Road on to Clontarf Road ending
at rear of Dart Station. Same route back.
Approx 1 hour in light traffic.
