## GOD COMES TO THOSE WHO WAIT FOR HIM

The 1st Sunday of Advent (Year C) starts a new liturgical year. This year, most of the Gospel readings will come from Luke.

Luke is believed to have been a doctor and a friend of St. Paul. He also wrote the Acts of the Apostles. Acts is not just a follow-up to his Gospel. Together, they tell the full story.

The story did not end with Jesus' Death, Resurrection, and Pentecost.

Instead, the early Christian community is shown as fulfilling God's promises. Luke writes about the destruction of Jerusalem and how Christianity spread. Persecutions and challenges did not stop the young Christian community. Instead, these difficulties helped spread Jesus' followers and allowed Christianity to grow quickly in many places. But not everyone recognised the Kingdom of God. We need to be attentive to see it.
