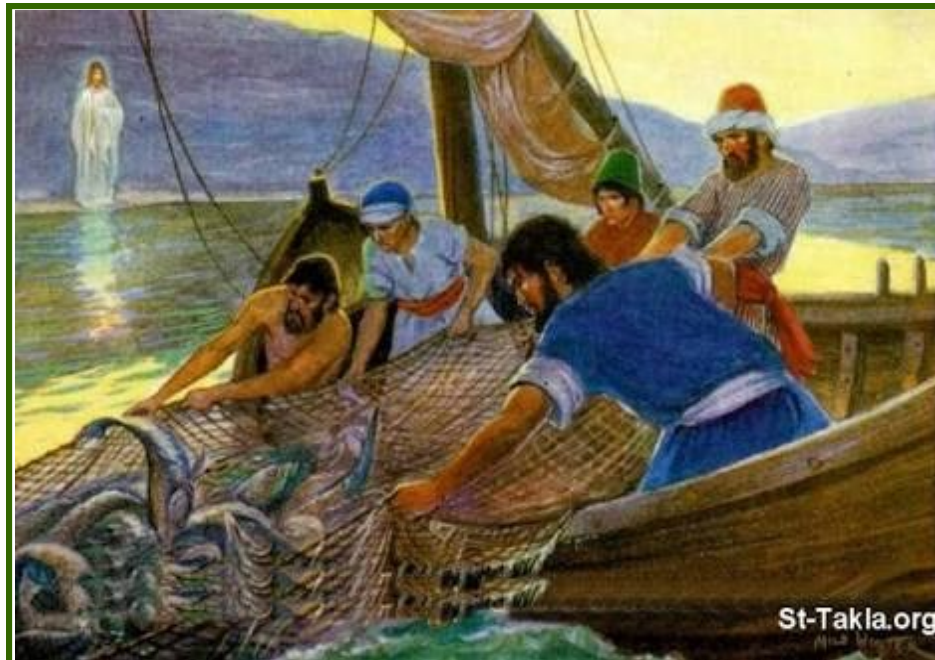

REFLECTION By Fr. Roger Landry

After Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon Peter, "Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a catch!" The Holy Father proposed Jesus' imperative "Put out into the deep water" as the motto of the Church.

He did this because so often we in the Church today can feel that we're in Peter's shoes. In many areas of life, but particularly in our discipleship, we can work so hard and seem to have so little to show for it. We're called, like Peter, Andrew, James and John to leave behind whatever might keep us from the Lord and follow him, being sent out into the deep water of the world to fish for souls. We're called, like St. Paul, to "work harder than any" of the rest, because of the Lord's great mercy, love and trust in calling us and sending us.

Three proposed Concerts in the Phoenix Park, Whitefields area: 20/21/22nd June 2025. Ref; OEL04/2025. Submissions should be sent before 18th February-NO FEE. It is on display to the public at DCC Planning Counter, Wood Quay. Submit your concerns, re damage to the Park; traffic; noise; use of public transport; outdoor crowds drinking etc. We always meet with promoters to express in detail, such concerns, and, encourage public transport use to the site to avoid too many cars. All planning issues are on line, with two screens for the public to access at the counter.

Three EIR Masts on the Scouts Den, Kinvara Road is a major concern for many. Planning for 'Retention' was lodged in January. Those with serious concerns should submit an objection letter, individually if possible, with the fee; in writing to Planning Dept., DCC, Wood Quay, Dublin 8; online to <https://planning.agileapplications.ie/dublincity/application-details/>?

Ref=WEB1081/25Closing date to submit is 20th February - **with €20.00 fee.** This will also go on public display at Wood Quay.
