THE IMPORTANCE OF THE HEART (Pope Francis-DILEXIT NOS)

"I have called you friends" (Jn 15:15). His open heart has gone before us and waits for us, unconditionally, asking only to offer us his love and friendship. For "he loved us first" (cf. 1 Jn 4:10). Because of Jesus, "we have come to know and believe in the love that God has for us" (1 Jn 4:16).

The symbol of the heart has often been used to express the love of Jesus Christ. Some have questioned whether this symbol is still meaningful today. Yet living as we do in an age of superficiality, rushing frenetically from one thing to another without really knowing why, and ending up as insatiable consumers and slaves to the mechanisms of a market unconcerned about the deeper meaning of our lives, all of us need to rediscover the importance of the heart.....If we devalue the heart, we also devalue what it means to speak from the heart, to act with the heart, to cultivate and heal the heart. If we fail to appreciate the specificity of the heart, we miss the messages that the mind alone cannot communicate; we miss out on the richness of our encounters with others; we miss out on poetry. We also lose track of history and our own past, since our real personal history is built with the heart. At the end of our lives, that alone will matter.

'Invalid' by Dublin City Council "due to a faulty Site Notice not on the Site, partially invisible " However, 3 new Site Notices were put up on 14th Feb.

DO NOT submit again, until you check with DCC Planning Ph. 01 2222288 to confirm the date the actual new planning is lodged with them, and also

get the new Planning Ref. No. You then have 5 weeks from THAT date to send in your submission. There is usually a time limit of 2 weeks from when the Site Notice was erected to formally

submit any planning application. Local residents have also confirmed with DCC, that the €20 fee submitted already will be refunded on request, OR, can be taken as fee for another submission, referencing the invalid notice and please request an acknowledgement.
