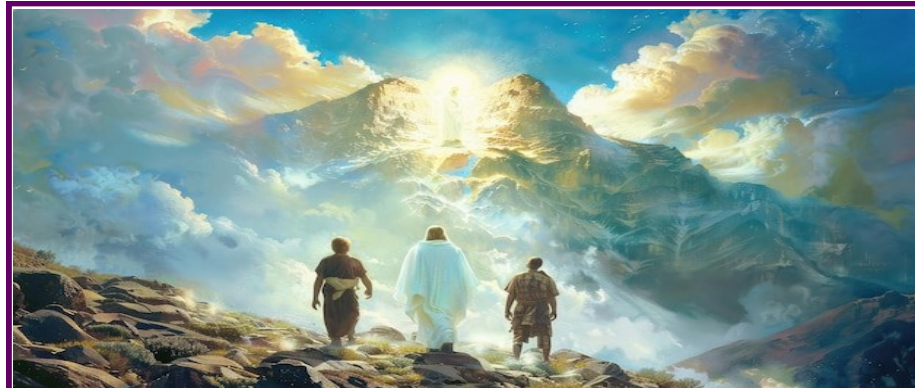

Centre during March;** Symbols of
Ireland, Feltmakers Ireland Group
Exhibition, daily until 30th March.

Tree Tour- Sunday 16th meet at
2.00p.m. for Seachtain na Gaeilge until
the 17th.

Word Wall Exhibition- A presentation
showing small pictures, with words
beside each, as Gaeilge - ideal for
children. **Mystery Tour** area for
children, showing aspects of the
Phoenix Park, via short tunnels.

Upstairs also holds the permanent
historical information exhibition on the
park, spanning 3500 B.C. to the present.

Walled Garden beside Visitor
Centre, flowers not yet in bloom; and a
lovely tree walk around periphery of
grounds The Park is a highly
important site for biodiversity in
Dublin City and supports 50% of the
mammal species found in Ireland,
about 40% of bird species, and some
rare and protected plant species.
