**Carlo Acutis: The First Millennial Saint**

Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonised next Sunday April 27, 2025, during the Church's Jubilee of Adolescents, making him the first millennial to be declared a saint. This event marks a significant milestone in the Catholic Church, recognising Acutis's life of faith and his innovative use of technology to spread the Gospel. The canonisation will take place in St. Peter's Square in Rome. Acutis, an Italian computer-coding teenager who died of cancer in 2006, is known for his great devotion to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Born in 1991, Shortly after his First Holy Communion at the age of 7, Acutis told his mother: "To always be united to Jesus: This is my life plan."
