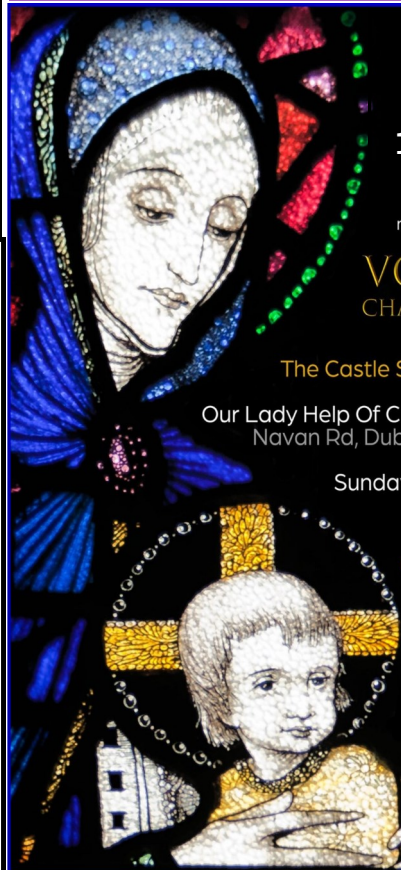

Day of Prayer for Vocations-Good Shepherd Sunday



Jesus, the Good Shepherd, calls others to help him in his shepherding, particularly those called to the ordained ministry as priests and deacons.

Certainly, all of the baptised are called to shepherd in some way. Spouses are to shepherd, guide, each other to God's pasture, and parents their children. Those called to a life of special consecration are called to shepherd God's people by their vowed commitment of poverty, chastity and obedience, reminding all that our true and lasting pasture is in the life to come. However, on Good Shepherd Sunday, we are called to pray in a special way for those called to be shepherds with the Good Shepherd through the administration of the sacraments:

those called to be priests and deacons.

Each celebration of the Mass is for the ordained person an opportunity to once again lay down his life for God's flock, to follow the Good Shepherd to the cross and to sacrifice himself along with the Lord so that blood and water might flow out for the salvation of the members of the flock.
