BLOOM- June Bank Holiday weekend - Thursday to Monday evening. Remember traffic will be heavy, be sure to have identity papers, with address, if driving, in case stewards attempt to turn you away from your home area.

Bus journeys, especially out of the city will be slow in the afternoons and evenings. **No access** to the Visitor Centre or public playground throughout the weekend unless attending Bloom. When BLOOM is over, work will have commenced at Whitefields area (inside Ashtown Gate-across North Road) to erect stages etc. for 3 Concerts on 20/21/22 June. The Visitor Centre will be open to all, but area beyond, at Whitefields will be full of heavy construction traffic/trucks, so take care.
