FROM NAVAN ROAD COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Following a recent meeting with Supt of K District, in
Blanchardstown Garda Station, with a Sub-committee
formed for this purpose the Supt requested we
urgently remind people **PLEASE LOCK YOUR CARS
OVERNIGHT and DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS ON
SEATS** - major reason for break-in to cars,
which, apart from theft, causes expensive damage.
At our Police Forum, a week later, listed Crime
Statistics showed : "In November, of 5 Thefts from vehi-
cles - 4 cars were unlocked"; "December, of 9 thefts
from vehicles - 2 were unlocked", "January, of 6 thefts
from cars - 2 were unlocked", and Feb., "the 1 theft
from vehicle, car was unlocked". Our main
reason for requesting a meeting with the Supt. was the
perceived 'Closure of Cabra Station overnight' by our
members and many others in the community The Supt
confirmed that "Only the Public Office in Cabra Station
is locked overnight, for security, but all operations
within the Station continue.
