Phoenix Park Concerts- the crowds were mostly peaceful, just a few problems to pass on to Aiken Promotions, OPW & DCC. The stage was down Monday evening and all is to be cleared by the 28th. The area is fully open to walk/cycle/drive.

MASTS on Scout Hall - we checked with DCC Planning Enforcement, who confirmed "DCC issued a Section 154 enforcement notice, requiring certain compliance steps to be taken, by the 2nd April. A planning application was then submitted for retention of the unauthorised development. Permission was granted on 10th April.

Subsequently appealed to An Bord Pleanála. Then, a request was made to extend the compliance period, and the deadline was extended to the 31st October, 2025, so that the appeal could be determined by An Bord Pleanála.
