REFLECTION

Sometimes, there is the risk of confining the Eucharist to a vague, distant dimension, perhaps bright and perfumed with incense, but distant from the straits of everyday life. In reality, the Lord takes all our needs to heart, beginning with the most basic. And he wants to set the example for his disciples, by saying, "You give them something to eat" (v. 13), to those people who had listened to him during the day. Our Eucharistic adoration comes alive when we take care of our neighbour like Jesus does. There is hunger for food around us, but also for companionship; there is hunger for consolation, friendship, good humour; there is hunger for attention, there is hunger to be evangelised. We find this in the Eucharistic Bread - Christ's attention to our needs and the invitation to do the same toward those who are beside us. We need to eat and feed others. (Pope Francis)

FROM NAVAN ROAD COMMUNITY COUNCIL**URGENT REMINDER** - Three Concerts in the Phoenix

Park 20/21/22 June at Whitefields, directly across from the Ash-town Gate area, across North Road. On Concert Days, Ashtown Gate will be closed to traffic & used as emergency/ambulance exit.

Regular Park users should be allowed pass through the two pedestrian gates. **Until 27th June** there will be no right turn as you drive in the Ashtown gate towards Mountjoy Cross (Ponds area). Concert gates open from 5.00 pm. Concert goes with tickets for "red area via Chesterfield Avenue" will be directed up Castleknock Road, in Castleknock Gate, back down Chesterfield Avenue to the venue - we appealed against this long route to no avail, as 'emergency area has to be a sterile area'. Two stile gates at Cumiskeys and The Hole in the Wall, should be open to regular Park users but could be shut, if dangerous/overcrowded. On Concert days - Castleknock Gate, inwards -closed from 4.00p.m. - 1.00a.m.; outward closed from 9.00p.m. - 1.00a.m. Odd Lamp Road (triangle area) is open to traffic for the same periods. Cabra gate, N.C.Rd & Knockmaroon Gate (all exit only) & Chapelizod Gate are all closed 4.00p.m. - 7.00p.m. on concert days, with access to St Marys Hospital and Cheshire

Home guaranteed.

Blackhorse Ave. from Nephin Rd. to Castleknock Road is closed from 4.00p.m. to 1.00a.m. on concert days, with local access guaranteed. **BE SURE TO HAVE IDENTITY WITH ADDRESS** if driving to gain home access and 'to prevent concert goers parking illegally'. Garda Patrols guaranteed within local residential areas, illegal parking 'will not be tolerated' with stewards also present at access points/ areas adjacent to Concert area. All areas outside the Park will be cleaned each evening, according to DCC and Fingal CC requirements'. The PHOENIX PARK REMAINS OPEN TO ALL, with restricted access near concert venue during construction, event days and restoration. Liaison: residents@aikenpromotions.com. Liaison office on concert days 085 2419815 - DCC officer from the Licence Dept. will be present also, throughout. Please take care when driving of walking concert goers.
