On Saturday 27th September at 2.00p.m. there will be a guided tour of the **Knockmaree Cromlech (burial tomb)** as part of the Dublin Festival of History.

The meeting point for the tour is at Cara Cheshire Home, upper Glen Road, Phoenix Park. It is from the Neolithic period, from about 3000 BC to 2500 BC, with a Capstone cover, believed to have come from the River Liffey - all discovered in 1838 by two workmen.

In the central burial chamber, measuring 1.20 metres (3 ft 11 in) by 0.60 metres (2 ft 0 in), two male skeletons were found in a crouched position. They were almost complete, aged about 40 and 50 years. Grave goods were found including many small perforated sea-shells (the flat periwinkle, *Littorina Obtusata*), which presumably formed a necklace, and a flint knife. In the outer cists, an urn and food vessels were found, with fragments of burnt bone and ashes.

The programme of outdoor tours- War Memorial Gardens, Arbour Hill, Grangegorman Military Cemetery, St. Marys, etc. continues until the end of October.
