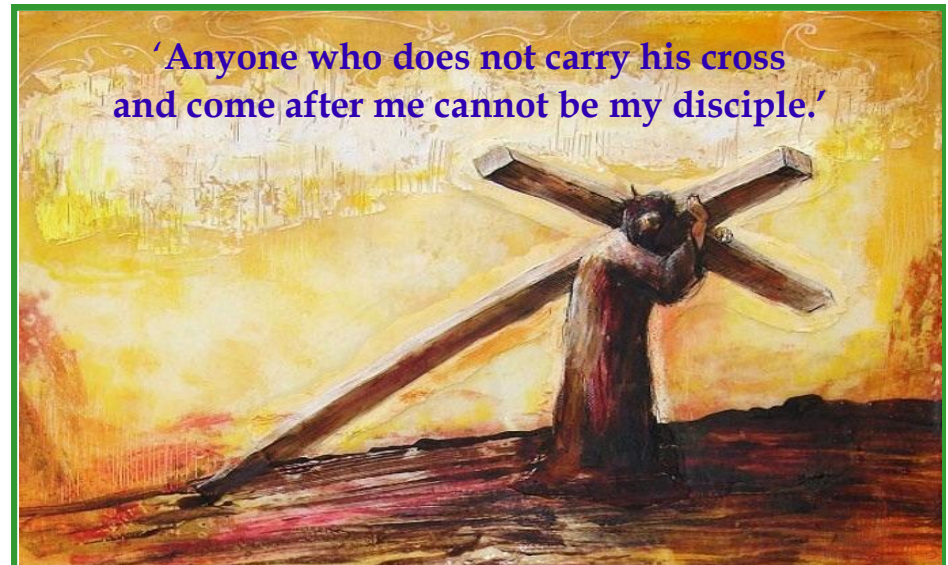

(Pope Francis, Angelus, 8th September 2013)

Jesus' disciple renounces all his possessions because in Jesus he has found the greatest Good in which every other good receives its full value and meaning. ..To explain this requirement, Jesus uses two parables: that of the tower to be built and that of the king going to war....Jesus does not wish to address the topic of war here; it is only a parable. Yet at this moment in which we are praying intensely for peace, this word of the Lord touches us to the core, and essentially tells us: there is a more profound war that we must all fight! It is the firm and courageous decision to renounce evil and its enticements and to choose the good, ready to pay in person: this is following Christ, this is what taking up our cross means! This profound war against evil! What is the use of waging war, so many wars, if you aren't capable of waging this profound war against evil? It is pointless! It doesn't work.... Among other things this war against evil entails saying "no" to the fratricidal hatred and falsehood that are used....

These are the enemies to fight, united and consistent, following no other interests than those of peace and of the common good.

Phoenix Park Honey Show & Biodiversity
Festival will take place at Visitor Centre on
Saturday next 6th September from
10.00a.m.to 5.00p.m.

BEWARE; following a recent successful
fraud within Kinvara area, a couple months
past, when an elderly person was persuaded
to pay out a sum of money to a group of
men, who pretended to be from the company
installing new Broadband boxes, under or
close to Gutters. They said the gutters had to
be cleaned out first, demanding a payment,
and came back more than once to the person
who first refused any payment, but they
succeeded in being paid after returning 2 or
3 times more. There was another attempted
fraud in recent weeks by group of men in
Ashtown, with a van resembling a DCC van
which empties bins etc., wearing hi -viz
jackets, this time they cut a couple of over-
hanging branches from a tree within a home
garden, saying they were DCC workers
having to cut overhanging branches, and
demanding €200/€250. On that occasion, the
elderly gentleman concerned was well able to
tell them to get away. PLEASE be wary, and
keep eye out for any vulnerable neigh-
bours. The Gardaí were notified at the
time, and we have alerted DCC Parks
Department to be aware in hope they might
publicise this danger to the public. Our
Chairperson is pursuing a date for **Navan
Road/Pelletstown Police Forum**, hopefully
our own next meeting will be in October.
