We are pleased to announce the launch of a new dedicated suicide bereavement support group in Blanchard-

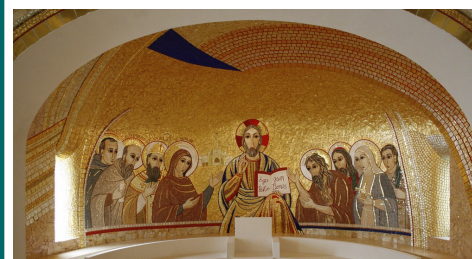
stown, North-West Dublin. **HUGG Support**
