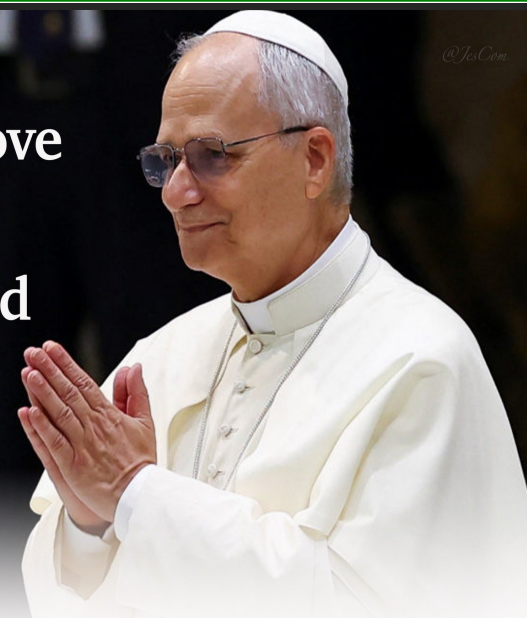

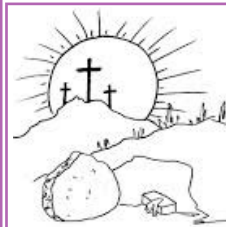

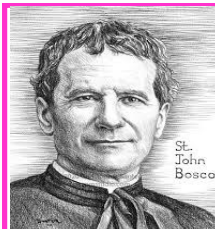
**EASTER CARD ART COMPETITION**

**FROM NAVAN ROAD COMMUNITY COUNCIL**

**BEWARE;** 3 Men in a white van on some local roads last week, offering 'roof jobs' - apart from suspicious, we are told they are quite intimidating. PLEASE be wary, and if possible, look out for vulnerable neighbours - call 999 as call goes on system immediately.

**Our item last week,** on 'Consultation' period for major change to our Planning Laws running throughout the Christmas period, we have submitted a short submission, lacking our usual full knowledge. We have written to our local T.D., and the relevant Minister, appealing to them, to at least put back out the entire 'Public Consultation, with all relevant information, so the public is properly informed, at least to end of month'. To date, neither acknowledgement or response from either. This matter comes under the Aarhus Convention 1998, only made

Law in Ireland in 2012 = a UN agreement guaranteeing citizens 3 key environmental rights, i.e., "Access to information; Public Participation; Access to Justice, a right to challenge environmental decisions in timely, affordable & fair legal review processes."
