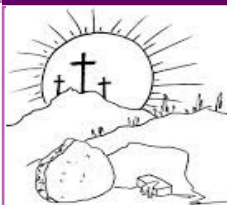

REFLECTION (Cistercians-Mount St. Joseph's Abbey)

There is no better time than Lent to begin listening afresh to Jesus. Listen to his Gospel words, his prompts, his teachings through the tradition of the Church, his influence upon countless saints who went before us. Let us listen in a new way. We should not demand miracles from God, but attentiveness from ourselves, patience to listen and respond, humility to see ourselves as we really are.

Sometimes, our own transfiguration can be painful. We are sometimes presented with a vision of ourselves that we do not like... a vision that other people see. Our more unpleasant nature is not lost on Jesus. When he was transfigured the disciples saw what was underneath: his greatness, his strength, his wonder, his god-ness. He knows, though, that we are human and that we harbour many fears. He knows we struggle and he wishes to help us. When we see ourselves, as we are from other standpoints, that too can be terrifying. But Jesus says do not be afraid... and we listen to him so that our lives may truly, in time, transfigure into the wonder of the presence of God.
