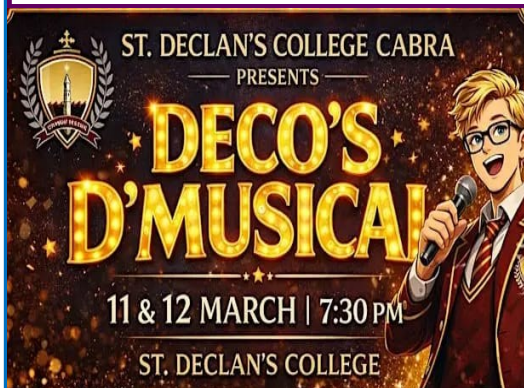

Government instructions to re-open
development plans to re-zone more
lands, relates to Fingal also. Our border
with Fingal is Ashtown. If you have

Re-zonings up in Scribblestown, over-
looking our entire area, would seriously
damage the Green Belt lands there,
which overlook the flood plain area
of Pelletstown lands - Pelletstown
Station flooded twice in recent
rains. The Tolka Bridge at Scribblestown
area was washed away in the 1950's. In
recent years when a major flood closed
River Road for over a week, a local resi-
dent within Scribblestown, with a Jeep
had to ferry An Teagasc staff back/forth
cross the same bridge as it flooded,
during that same week
