Canal Towpath closure-We can confirm
the Towpath, whilst closed for Green-
way works from the Ashtown end to the
entrance to small Crescent Park in
Pelletstown, is accessible from
Ashington/Kinvara direction. One can
cross over the walkway at Pelletstown
Station onwards. The works end just
west of the entrance to the park/
playground, with access to the park, or
further into the Pelletstown areas, and/
or Tolka Valley Park, with main entrance
at the River Road from Scribblestown
Cross area, and one further eastward
along River Road - opposite Pelletstown
development. **Lovely walks in Tolka
Valley Park** from Ashtown to Ratoath
Road area, or crossing over road,
onwards past the Ballybogan area.

PIETA HOUSE will hold their
'Darkness into Light' 5K walk on Satur-
day 9th May, beginning 4.15 am on
Chesterfield Avenue, near Phoenix
roundabout. Parts of Chesterfield
Avenue are closed from 7.00p.m. Friday
