Bus Connects-we attended the High Court last week, no Judgement yet on the Judicial Review, taken by a business on the route. The issue only relates to the specific matter/s raised by that Judicial Review, not any other issue along the route. It is now listed for the 22nd June 2026. At least we have our wonderful avenue of trees left in place, for this year (see the Cherry Trees opposite our church/a wonder indeed, surviving the winds so far). 200 + trees are listed for demolition between Skreen Road and Auburn Avenue for Bus Connects.

CANAL TOWPATH - For those who walk the Towpath between Ashtown/Ashington areas, NOTE; "Towpath is Closed for Greenway re-surfacing works from the 13th April until the 13th July" between the towpath entrance at Ashtown to the small Pelletstown Park, with playground. You need to check if access to that park & playground is free from the Ashington direction. The Towpath is being done in stages to the Docklands.
