"The story of Pentecost is not just a story for that one locked room. It is for every one of us who's ever felt ashamed, unworthy, or afraid to stand before God. Jesus says '*Peace be with you*' not as a suggestion, but as a gift.

You don't have to be a perfect person for the Holy Spirit to work wonders through you. The disciples were ordinary people: full of doubts, regrets and rough edges. But when the Holy Spirit comes, those locked doors open wide. The Spirit meets us as we are, and gives us courage, the words, and the love we need to build up the Church and the world around us.

The Spirit's gifts aren't just for the chosen few. Each of us receives them in unique ways: through our personalities, our strengths, even our weaknesses. Some of us build up the body of Christ with patience, others with kindness or faithfulness, still others with gentleness or self-control. These are fruits of the Holy Spirit, growing quietly within us.

**FROM NAVAN ROAD COMMUNITY
COUNCIL**

BEWARE AND BE VIGILANT: please
be aware, and warn others who might
be vulnerable, that scams and attempt-
ed scams have continued throughout
the area, as set out in last week's News-
letter. Offers to repair roof tiles; do
garden work; cut hedges etc, warning of
'a wasps nest' are all being used to gain
access to peoples homes.

PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW any person
you do not know, or did not request, to
enter your home, or do out-door works,
for which they will then attempt to over-
charge you. If worried, try to ring an
agreed neighbour, and always call 999 or
112, if from your mobile phone - the
matter will be registered, and they can
call out a Garda car. Our community
Gardaí have asked that people do this, as
if you ring Cabra Station, they might not
have a car immediately free. With
neighbourly agreement, try to share each
other's phone number for such
occasions, or if you live alone.

WhatsApp & Facebook groups are
sharing warnings. During a recent over-
night break in, near Ashtown, three cars
were stolen, as keys were taken from
inside. **REMEMBER** to lock your cars
overnight, and do not leave car keys
easily visible through doors or windows
downstairs.
