The Church God is Now Giving Us – and its Challenge (Archbishop Dermot Farrell)

"As I said at the beginning, in every parish in our diocese, there are people of deep faith and profound commitment: people whose faith is alive. All of these people have a multitude of gifts, and these gifts are often used for the good of their communities. But these gifts remain somehow hidden: some are veiled from those who use them; some are buried waiting to be brought to life. The challenge for the Church in Dublin and beyond, is to welcome these gifts, and empower people to give of their gifts. In my years as parish priest and bishop, I have seen how rich and varied and necessary those gifts are. Parishes are crying out for leadership and accompaniment in prayer groups, youth groups, in sacramental preparation for children, in funeral ministry, in outreach to the poor and disadvantaged, and that list could be expanded.

What is important is that we realise that all these gifts are there – they are actually there, and they are necessary. All are necessary. It is the People of God as a whole that has the totality of the gifts; the gifts are distributed across the Body of Christ. The challenge – the great challenge – of the Church in Dublin, and in Ireland, today is to empower people to use their gifts."
