THEME FOR 'THE SEASON OF CREATION'2026: LIVING WATER

Jesus uses the phrase 'Living Water' to describe the eternal life and the Holy Spirit that he offers to believers. (John 7:27). The theme for the 2026 Season of Creation is "Living Water", inspired by Ezekiel 47:1-12. In the prophet's vision, water flows from the Temple and gradually becomes a great river. Wherever it flows, life flourishes: barren land becomes fertile, salt water turns fresh, fish abound, trees bear fruit every month, and their leaves bring healing. This powerful image reminds us that God's presence always brings life, healing, hope, and renewal. The symbol chosen for this year is "*Immersion in Living Water,*" inviting Christians not simply to admire God's gifts but to immerse themselves more deeply in God's life and mission. The theme is also particularly relevant today because access to clean water is one of the world's greatest environmental and humanitarian challenges. Pollution, drought, floods, shrinking glaciers, and unequal access to drinking water affect millions of people across the globe. The Church therefore invites us to recognise water as a sacred gift from God that must be protected for present and future generations.

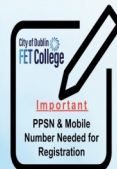
